- Dianne: When we went to OneASME, we encouraged \$500 TC awards. Each TC has given out a \$500 paper award. This will make it difficult for ASME to discontinue awards if historical records for giving out awards is for 7 years. It is up to us to provide commonality within TCs for types of paper awards, e.g. journals, conference. Can add topics to leadership summit, maybe ½ working meeting for coming to a common ground on commonality of TC awards.
